## Here are the guidelines:

- Your poster must promote 4-H and include the 4-H emblem. When using the 4-H emblem on a poster, follow criteria specified by the national guidelines regarding the 4-H emblem. Do not place text or other images over or on top of the 4-H emblem. No photo, drawing, symbol, word or other figure or object may be placed on or obscure the 4-H emblem. The official colors should not be altered. The clover stem should turn to the right only and the clover should not be slanted.
- Posters must be horizontal only.
- Name, address, county, age, grade, school and email address of the 4-H member must be included with submission.
- Choose a catchy theme or title.
- Design must be original and relate to the theme.
- Well-known cartoon figures cannot be used because they are copyrighted such as Marvel super heroes, Disney characters, Lego characters, etc.
- Posters can be done in PowerPoint, google slides, and then save your file as a pdf and emailed to 4-H.
